Discussion Items

- Initial Costs presented: table cloths, bins for ice, water, juice boxes, minimum for food trucks, ~ \$5000-\$6000
- Should we charge a ticket price, that could cover the cost of the food trucks \$25/adult, \$10/child.
- Discussion around cost and some of the challenges.
- North park has a rule that money cannot exchange hands in the park. Not an opportunity for families to pay for food directly.
- Nate will ask if we can pre-order from the trucks ahead of time with the trucks.
- Agreement that pre-ordering through the event rise platform would be best option.
- APTA voted to fund the Kona Ice truck (\$399 for 90 minutes).
- Still need volunteers for the day of the event.
- No bounce house, will bring some balls/games/cornhole instead. Advertise on flyer to bring your own games.

Conclusion reached: Families will use GiveSmart to order food *if they want* ahead of time. They can also bring food. This reduces the number of food trucks to the Hermes truck only (no minimum) and reduces the cost of the event drastically. Instead of paying for a ticket, we can now ask for a small donation if people want.
